

# 2012–13 ENROLMENT FOR FIRST ENTRY INTO THE BERMUDA PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM

Enrolment for first entry into the Bermuda Public School System will occur on the following dates:

**MONDAY, 6 FEBRUARY, TUESDAY, 7 FEBRUARY, WEDNESDAY, 8 FEBRUARY, THURSDAY, 9 FEBRUARY  
AND FRIDAY, 10 FEBRUARY 2012** | Application forms are available online at [www.moed.bm](http://www.moed.bm) and at all primary schools.

## PROCEDURES FOR ENROLMENT

- In all cases, parents must complete the application form, attach a copy of a passport or birth certificate and ensure that the application is submitted in accordance with the directions on the form.
- Parents of non-Bermudian children must provide documentation from the Department of Immigration confirming that the child is a bona fide resident of Bermuda.
- The manager or principal of a private school must, on request from the Ministry of Education, submit the official transcript of any student who has applied to be admitted in a maintained or aided school..

## CONDITIONS OF ENROLMENT

### **PRESCHOOL**

1. Children must celebrate their fourth birthday between 1 January 2012 and 31 December 2012.
2. Children must reside in the same parish as the preschool to which application is made with the exception of Lyceum, Devonshire, Prospect and Warwick Preschools.
3. Parents of children not initially accepted may contact the Education Officer for Early Childhood Education and request that their child's name be placed on the waiting list.

### **PRIMARY SCHOOL**

1. Children must celebrate their fifth birthday between 1 January 2012 and 31 December, 2012.
2. Children must reside in the same zone as the primary school to which the application is made.
3. Priority in enrolment may be given to siblings of students already attending the school to which the application is made and who reside in the same zone

4. Where a school is located close to the end of a zone boundary, priority may be given to children who reside between the school and the zone boundary over children who may live closer, but towards the centre of the zone.
5. Parents of children not initially accepted should contact the principal of the preferred school and request that their child's name be placed on the waiting-list.

### **MIDDLE SCHOOL**

1. A child is eligible for enrolment at their feeder middle school. (Subject to 2)
2. Parents who have changed residence during the two years immediately preceding admission may request placement at the middle school which is nearest to their residence.
3. A child not currently enrolled in the Bermuda Public School System shall make application to the Department of Education, but can deliver the application to the middle school closest to their residence or to the Department of Education, 14 Waller's Point Road, St. David's DD 03 **NO LATER THAN 3:30 P.M. ON FRIDAY, 10 FEBRUARY 2012.**
