

ENROLMENT FOR FIRST ENTRY INTO THE BERMUDA PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM

Enrolment for first entry into the Bermuda Public School System will occur on the following dates:

WEDNESDAY, 3 FEBRUARY 2010 | THURSDAY, 4 FEBRUARY 2010 | FRIDAY, 5 FEBRUARY 2010

A limited number of forms will be available at all post offices and the Department of Education, Dundonald Street, Hamilton from Monday, 1 February 2010. Parents of students already enrolled in the Bermuda Public School System will receive pre-printed personalized application forms and therefore do not need to collect forms from the post offices.

PROCEDURES FOR ENROLMENT

- In all cases, parents must complete the enrolment form in full, attach the required documentation and ensure that the application is submitted in accordance with the directions on the form.
- Enrolment of children shall occur without regard to race, religion or national origin.
- Parents of non-Bermudian children must provide documentation from the Ministry of Labour, Home Affairs and Housing confirming that the child is a bona fide resident of Bermuda.

CONDITIONS OF ENROLMENT

PRESCHOOL

1. Children must celebrate their fourth birthday between 1 January 2010 and 31 December 2010.
2. Children must reside in the same parish as the preschool to which application is made.
3. *Prospect Preschool* will accept applications from residents of Devonshire, Pembroke and Smith's Parishes. *Warwick Preschool* will accept applications from the residents of Southampton Parish who live east of the access roads to the Fairmont Southampton Hotel. *Southampton Preschool* will accept applications from persons living in Sandys Parish, providing the home address falls within the MA 06 postal zone.
4. Priority in enrolment will be given to younger four year olds, that is, to those children born during the latter part of the year.
5. Parents of children not initially accepted may contact the Education Officer for Early Childhood Education and request that their child's name be placed on the waiting list. As vacancies occur, administrators will admit applicants according to the criteria above.

PRIMARY SCHOOL

1. Children must celebrate their fifth birthday between 1 January 2010 and 31 December, 2010.
2. Children must reside in the same zone as the primary school to which application is made.
3. Priority in enrolment will be given to siblings of students in Primary 1 through Primary 5 already attending the school to which application is made.
4. Thereafter, if the school is over-subscribed, priority in admissions will be given to in-zone residents who reside nearest that school.
5. Parents of children not initially accepted should contact the principal of the preferred school and request that their child's name be placed in the waiting-list. As vacancies become available, principals will admit applicants according to the criteria cited above.

MIDDLE SCHOOL

1. (Subject to 2) A child is eligible for enrolment only at that middle school which is in the same family of schools as the primary school which the child currently attends.
2. Parents who have changed residence during the two years immediately preceding admission may request placement at the middle school which is nearest to their current residence.
3. A child not currently attending a primary school on the Bermuda Public School System may enroll only in that middle school which is nearest to that child's place of residence.
4. In the case of students already attending a Government primary school, return the completed form and required documents to your child's current primary school NO LATER THAN 3:30 P.M. ON FRIDAY, 5 FEBRUARY 2010.
5. In all other cases, submit the completed application and required documents to the Ministry of Education, Dundonald Street, NO LATER THAN 3:30 P.M. ON FRIDAY, 5 FEBRUARY 2010.

SENIOR SCHOOL

1. All students eligible for enrolment in a senior school shall make application to either of the two senior schools. If either senior school is oversubscribed, then random selection shall take place.
2. In the case of those students already attending a Government middle school, return the completed application form and required documents to the child's current middle school NO LATER THAN 3:30 P.M. ON FRIDAY, 5 FEBRUARY 2010.
3. In other cases, submit the completed application form and required documents to the Department of Education, Dundonald Street, Hamilton NO LATER THAN 3:30 P.M. ON FRIDAY, 5 FEBRUARY 2010.
