

Short Guide to the Minister's Applied Tech Scholarship

About

This guide was developed to help you apply for the Minister's Applied Tech Scholarship. This award was designed to help graduating dual enrolment students of CedarBridge Academy and The Berkeley Institute complete their Associate's Degree at Bermuda College.

Value

This scholarship is valued at \$5,000 for attendance at Bermuda College.

Term

The award is tenable for one year.

Eligibility

In order to apply, you must:

- i. Be graduating from CedarBridge Academy or The Berkeley Institute in 2019
- ii. Be a dual-enrolment student in the Applied Technology Programme at Bermuda College
- iii. Have a minimum GPA of 2.0
- iv. Have participated in extra-curricular and/or community service in school and/or the community
- v. Be Bermudian, and
- vi. Have been educated in Bermuda for at least 5 years.

Minister's Applied Tech Scholarship Application Questions

Instructions

1. Please read the instructions and the essay questions carefully.
2. Your essay answers must be typed in a single Word document and uploaded as part of your application on Bermudascholarships.com. Your answers should be 100 to 250 words in length.
3. You must make sure that your full name and the date are typed at the top of the page of your essay question answer.
4. Please type the essay question and type the essay answer immediately under the essay question.

Application Questions

1. What difference will this scholarship make to you?
2. Please tell us about your technical and/or vocational interests and career aspirations.

Application Tips

You should:

- **Begin your application as soon as possible.** Don't wait until the last minute in case you have problems getting all of the documents or have computer problems.
- **Ask for help** so that someone else can help you review and proofread your application. They can make sure that you have all of the needed documents and read over your answers.
- **Ask people who will write good letters to be your references.** Ask early enough to give them time to write strong letters of recommendation.
- **Read and reread the questions asked so that you understand what is being asked.**
- **Make sure that you answer the questions that are asked,** rather than submit a personal essay.
- **Reflect on the questions.** Think about your experiences, accomplishments, challenges, how you have grown, successes, and what you are good at. You should also think about what you are going to study and how getting this scholarship would help you achieve your goals.
- **Even if you have someone helping you, you should carefully review your own application.** Make sure that you edit your answers so that they are clear and don't have any mistakes. Be sure to check that you have all of the documents needed for your application.
