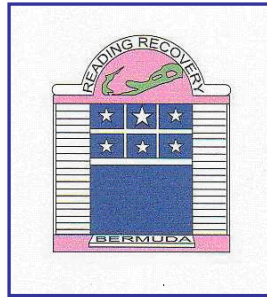

READING RECOVERY TEACHER TRAINING COMMITMENT



The success of Reading Recovery depends on the commitment of teachers to fully participate in all training activities and to teach Reading Recovery strategies to children. Teachers are expected to remain in Reading Recovery, for a minimum of three years, barring exceptional circumstances. However, this requirement may be waived if the Director of Academics, in consultation with the Reading Education Officer and Principal, determines that the best interests of the intervention and the teacher may be served by earlier withdrawal.
