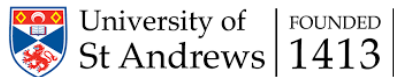


Short Guide to the Bermuda to St. Andrews Scholarship

Scholarship Vision

The Bermuda to St. Andrews Scholarship is a full scholarship introduced to help high achieving students with leadership potential attend the University of St. Andrews Scotland for undergraduate study.

Why St. Andrews?

St. Andrews is a highly respected and competitive university, located 90 minutes from Edinburgh. It offers a number of diverse programmes across 4 faculties of Arts, Divinity, Medicine and Science. In addition to offering highly sought after degrees, the University is committed to providing high levels of student support and unique student experiences.

Value

Generously funded by donors Messrs. Chris Maybury and Karim Alibhai, principal and owner of Rosewood Bermuda, this scholarship fully funds undergraduate study at the University of St. Andrews. Valued at £22,900 for British Overseas Territory fee status students, and £35,000 for international fee status students, the scholarship will cover tuition, accommodation, food, a computer and return airfare.

Term

The award is tenable for 4 years for an undergraduate programme of study at the University of St. Andrews.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

1. Be graduating or have graduated from senior school
2. Not be attending university abroad or have an undergraduate degree
3. Be not older than 25 years on September 1st, 2018

4. Have a track record of high academic achievement, including a minimum GPA of 3.0
5. Have demonstrated academic achievement commensurate with the requirements of acceptance to the University of St. Andrews (e.g. external examinations such as Advanced Subsidiary (AS)/Advanced Placement (AP)/Scholastic Achievement Test (SAT)/ACT, good grades in post-secondary courses or obtained the Bermuda College's Associate of Arts Degree with good grades)
6. Have applied to the University of St. Andrews prior to making a scholarship application
7. Be accepted to the University of St. Andrews by the time of the scholarship interview
8. Have made a significant contribution to community service in excess of the minimum requirements of graduation
9. Be Bermudian
10. Have attended school in Bermuda for at least 5 years, and
11. Demonstrate financial need.

Application Procedure

At the request of the scholarship donors, the recipient selection process is being undertaken by the Ministry of Education and Workforce Development via a scholarship committee. In its discretion, this scholarship committee or a representative of the Ministry may ask you for additional documents to help support your application. If you do not submit the requested documents, you may be disqualified from consideration.

Application Requirements

Please carefully review this scholarship for eligibility and application requirements. To be considered, you must follow the application instructions and make sure that your application is complete and

submitted by the deadline of April 30th, 2018. There is no guarantee that late or incomplete applications will be considered.

Bermuda to St. Andrews Scholarship Essay

You must submit a personal essay describing your interest in the University of St. Andrews, the course of study being pursued and the contribution you plan to make to Bermuda upon completion of your studies. Your personal essay should not exceed 500 words.

Scholarship Interviews

Shortlisted candidates must be available for interviews during the month of May.
