

Short Guide to the Minister's Technical and Vocational Award

About

This guide was developed to help you apply for the Minister's Technical and Vocational Award.

This award was designed to help promising public school students and public school alumni at Bermuda College who have a strong interest in technical and vocational areas attend local or overseas post-secondary education.

Value

This scholarship is valued at up to \$7,500 for local and up to \$25,000 for overseas education.

Term

The award is tenable for the length of your post-secondary programme of study for up to 4 years.

Application Requirements

Please carefully review scholarships and awards for eligibility and application requirements. To be considered, you must follow the application instructions and ensure that your application is complete and submitted by the deadline of April 15th, 2026. All applications must be submitted on Bermudascholarships.com. Should you experience challenges with uploading documents, please refer to the HELP feature on the Bermuda Scholarships website. **Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.**

Eligibility

In order to apply, you must:

- i. Be pursuing technical and vocational fields of need in Bermuda*
- ii. Be a public school graduate
- iii. Be between the ages of 16 and 25 years as of September 1st, 2026
- iv. Have a minimum GPA of 2.0
- v. Have participated in extra-curricular and/or community service in school and/or the community
- vi. Be a Bermudian
- vii. Have been educated in Bermuda for at least 5 years, and
- viii. Demonstrate financial need.

*Technical and Vocational Areas Covered by this Award

If you do not submit the required documents by the time requested, you will be disqualified from consideration.

Minister's Technical and Vocational Award Application Questions

Instructions

1. Please read the instructions and the essay questions carefully.
2. Your answer must be typed in a single Word document and uploaded as part of your application on [Bermudascholarships.com](http://bermudascholarships.com).
3. Your answers should be no more than 250 words.
4. Ensure that your full name and the date are typed at the top of the page of your essay question answers.
5. Please type the essay questions and type the essay answers immediately under the essay questions.

Essay Questions

1. Explain your educational & career goals in your chosen technical and vocational field. How did you decide on this career choice and college/university, and how do you plan to use these skills to make an impact in the community?
2. What has been your most meaningful learning experience outside of school, and what did this experience teach you about your goals, values and perspective on life?
3. How would receiving this scholarship help you specifically and how will you fund your education if you are not successful?

Application Tips

You should:

- **Begin your application as soon as possible.** Don't wait until the last minute in case you have problems getting all of the documents or technical difficulties.
- **Ask for help** so that someone else can help you review and proofread your application. They can ensure that you have all of the needed documents and read over your answers.
- **Ask people who will write good letters to be your references.** Ask early enough to give them time to write strong letters of recommendation.

- **Read and reread the question asked so that you understand what is being asked.**
- **Ensure that you answer the application question asked**, rather than submit a personal essay.
- **Reflect on the question.** Think about your experiences, challenges, how you have grown, successes, and what you are good at. You should also think about what you are going to study and how getting this award would help you achieve your goals.
- **Even if you have someone helping you, you should carefully review your own application.** Ensure that you edit your answers so that they are clear and don't have any mistakes. Be sure to check that you have all of the documents needed for your application.
